This year's busy summer and busy weekends are great for business. There is one unfortunate problem that never seems to be resolved. The washrooms are closed Friday at 4:00 pm and do not open until Monday morning. We have tourists all weekend, and at a heavier volume than during the week.

I understand that town public works see's to the locking, opening and cleaning of these facilities. It is not working.

This puts the burden of washroom facilities on the business community and the visitors centre who have to bear the cost of this.

The town received a grant to provide these facilities and the agreement of the town was to maintain them. This is in fact not happening.

Many, many complaints have been made over the past 4 or 5 years, and the complaints fell on deaf ears

Why is there a problem ? The town administration and finance officer are supposed to administer to a schedule and find a way to have them maintained at a reasonable rate This problem has never been addressed, no solutions have been tried.
